# Count 1

Cruelty to Animals

In Violation Of:

Penalty:

343.21 Subd. 7 and 9(d) 0-2 years and/or \$5,000 fine

On or between May 5, 2008, and May 17, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, willfully instigated or in any way further acted cruelly towards a pet or companion animal or caused an act tending to produce cruelty to animals, which resulted in death or great bodily harm, specifically, a female Bichon.

# Count 2

Cruelty to Animals

In Violation Of:

343.21 Subd. 7 and 9(d)

Penalty: 0-2 years and/or \$5,000 fine

On or between May 1, 2008, and May 12, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, willfully instigated or in any way further acted cruelly towards a pet or companion animal, or caused an act tending to produce cruelty to animals, which resulted in death or great bodily harm, specifically, a female Pug.

### Count 3

Cruelty to Animals

In Violation Of:

343.21 Subd. 7 and 9(d)

Penalty:

0-2 years and/or \$5,000 fine

On or about May 17, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, willfully instigated or in any way further acted cruelly towards a pet or companion animal, or caused an act tending to produce cruelty to animals, which resulted in death or great bodily harm, specifically, a Shih Tzu located in a pen in the red barn.

## Count 4

Cruelty to Animals

In Violation Of: 343.21 Subd. 7 and 9(d)

Penalty:

0-2 years and/or \$5,000 fine

On or between April 23, 2008, and May 23, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, willfully instigated or in any way furthered act of cruelly to animals which resulted in substantial bodily harm in a pet or companion animal.

# Count 5

Torture

In Violation Of:

343.21 Subd. 1 and 9(b)

Penalty:

0-1 years and/or \$3,000 fine

On or between April 23, 2008, and May 23, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, did torture, neglect or unjustifiably injure, maim, mutilate or kill any animal, whether it belongs to that person or another person, and that animal was a pet or companion animal and the violation resulted in substantial bodily harm to the pet or companion animal.

## Count 6

**Torture** 

In Violation Of:

343.21 Subd. 1 and 9(b)

0-90 days and/or \$1,000 fine

On or between May 3 and 4, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, did torture, neglect or unjustifiably injure, maim, mutilate or kill any animal, whether it belongs to that person or another person.

## Count 7

Cruelty to Animals

In Violation Of: 343.21 Subd. 7

0-90 days and/or \$1,000 fine Penalty:

On or between April 23, 2008, and May 23, 2008, within the County of Otter Tail, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, did willfully instigate or acted cruelly towards any animal or animals, or any act tending to produce cruelty to animals.

## Count 8

Veterinarians-Practice Without License or Permit

In Violation Of: 156.10

Penalty:

0-1 year and/or \$3,000 fine

On or between April 22, 2008, and May 9, 2008, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, did practice veterinary medicine in the state without having first secured a veterinary license or temporary permit provided Penicillin, Banamine and Genocin to animals at Pick of the Litter.

## Count 9

Veterinarians-Practice Without License or Permit

In Violation Of:

156.10

Penalty: 0-1 year and/or \$3,000 fine

On or between April 22, 2008, and May 9, 2008, one Kathy Jo Bauck, the defendant, did practice veterinary medicine in the state without having first secured a veterinary license or temporary permit by cropping a litter of Schnauser puppies' ears.
