## DETAILS:

On 11-07-96, I was contacted by Lieutenant Raymond Polensky for my assistance in an investigation that possibly involved inhumane treatment to animals and possibly, some false registration of AK $\zeta$  see registered dogs. I learned from Lieutenant Polensky that the puppy mill was located in Pine Lake Township in Otter Tail County. Based upon Lieutenant Polensky's investigation report, I obtained a search warrant for this location on 11-07-96 and executed the search warrant at the Kathy and Allen Bauck farm on 11-08-96.

Present at the time of executing the search warrant was myself, Lieutenant Polensky, Dr. William Rose-Veterinarian from Perham, Dr. Terry Boldingh-on the State Board of Animal Health for the State of Minnesota, Detective Sergeant Michael McCormick, and Police Chief Greg Ripley of New York Mills. We proceeded with the search warrant and at that time, I was in accompaniment of Dr. Boldingh and Kathy Bauck, examined the facility for cleanliness or any other conditions that may exist. In the course of our examination, we were unable to find anything that was a major problem or that should warrant any type of criminal charging. Dr. Boldingh has also written a letter to myself in regards to this matter which is also attached to this report. Taken from the home at that time, with the assistance of Chief Greg Ripley and the assistance of Allen Bauck, were copies of their computer records. Also, we obtained photo copies of their puppy log book. These items have been retained by the Otter Tail County Sheriff's Dept. At this time, we observed no criminal activity in this case. This case is considered closed.
